### Class Description

### Class Options

\*Unless noted otherwise, classes will be working through our **Shalom of God** series.

**20's and 30's – Room 216/217.** 20's and 30's is a class made up of marrieds and singles in their 20's and 30's. It is the landing spot for graduate transfers, young professionals, and anyone else in the early stages of their family and career. Facilitators: various.
